The primary purpose of the association is to create a culture of cooperation and solidarity for all disadvantaged groups of the society, including the disabled, women, youth and the elderly. It works to enable disabled people to participate in socioeconomic life. He organized trainings for disabled individuals and their families on increasing their digital skills, safe internet use, cyberbullying and e-commerce. Location

We are located in Eskişehir, one of the most breathtaking destinations in Central Anatolia. Eskişehir is a province and the twenty-fifth most populous city in Turkey. In addition, in terms of population, it is the 4th largest province of the Central Anatolia region after Ankara, Konya and Kayseri. It became a Metropolitan Municipality with the law enacted in 1993. Its population is 898,369 according to TUIK statistics for 2021.

What are the activities and experiences of the partner organization.

2019- Youth with Limited Responsibility and Special Needs Cooperative: Families of our youth with intellectual disabilities who received cooperative education within the scope of BEBKA Technical Support Grant Program in 2019. I am the founding partner and chairman of the board of our cooperative. Our cooperative is also managing 4 workshops, which we established with the SOGEP grant in 2019, in which our Governorship is a partner, and where our young people can gain professional competence and participate in socio-economic life by working.

Our cooperative, which has the distinction of being the first publicly supported social cooperative of our country, was selected as the best starting cooperative in 2022 and honored with a monetary award by the European International Cooperatives Institution (CEFEC), headquartered in Lithuania and to which cooperatives from many European countries are members.

Şenay KIZILKUM: Subject is the founding chairman. She also works as a project specialist in the EU and Foreign Relations Project Office of the Governorship of Eskişehir. She is experienced in national and international projects. They are key personnel in the association's cooperation with local public institutions, universities and other non-governmental organizations. In 2019, he established a social cooperative called "Youth with Special Needs Cooperative". The aim of the cooperative is to increase the competence of individuals with intellectual disabilities through vocational training and to ensure their participation in employment. He received a project grant from the Ministry of Industry and Technology in Turkey and worked as a coordinator in the establishment of 4 workshops where individuals with intellectual disabilities can work.

These workshops are cafe, car wash, assembly packaging and laundry-dry cleaning. He continues to work voluntarily as the founding partner of the cooperative.

Gülben CURA: She is the Founding Vice President of the Association. She also works in Eskişehir Provincial Culture and Tourism Directorate, Eskişehir Governor's Office and Investment monitoring and Coordination unit. She has her BA and MA on Tourism and Tourist Guidance and she is doing her PhD at Eskişehir Osmangazi University. She is actively involved in Eskişehir tourism studies, project writing and project execution, and carries out Eskişehir Rural Tourism Develops Ka104 project she. At the same time, she takes part voluntarily in helping women and their families with disabilities in different women's associations in order to help disadvantaged groups in terms of social responsibility and support.
